

The director has **come in for** a lot of criticism over his handling of the affair.

استلم العديد من النقد

come out in -If you come out in something, such as spots, they appear on your skin-

This heat has made me **come out in** an itchy red rash.

تخرجفي

come up against - Be faced with or opposed by.

The project **came up against** a lot of criticism.

صطدم

come up with - Produce an idea or plan

Sacha **came up with** a great idea for the party.

ياتي بقكرة

cut down on - Reduce in number or size.

The doctor told him to **cut down on** cigarettes.

خفض

do away with - Get rid of; abolish

Some people think it's time to **do away** with the monarchy.

تخلص من الغي

face up to - Accept ad deal with something unpleasant

Sam will have to **face up to** the fact that Jenny is not in love with him.

مواجهة

feel up to - to have the energy to do something

لدي الطاقة لعمل شئ ما

I don't **feel up to** going out tonight.

get along with - Be on good terms / work well with

انسجم مع

I get along (well) with my mother-in-law.

get away with – to succeed in avoiding punishment for something **-** Escape with

تفلت من العقاب

If I thought I could **get away with** it, I wouldn't pay any tax at all.

	get down to - Start to actually do something	It's time to get down to some serious work!
	get on with - Have a good relationship with	I get on very well with my colleagues.
	get out of Leave الخروج من	How did he get out of the house?
	get rid of – to remove or throw away something unwanted -to sell an old or unwanted possession - to send away someone annoying or to persuade them to leave Eliminate	That cream got rid of my skin rash. I used weedkiller to get rid of the weeds in the garden. Have you managed to get rid of your old Volvo yet? We got rid of our unwelcome guests by saying we had to go to bed.
	get round to - Find the necessary time to do something الحصول على جولة للقيام بذلك	I finally got round to making the list that I promised.
