(separable): return
something

bring off (separable):
accomplish something difficult;
accomplish something people
had considered impossible or
unlikely

It was a difficult task but we **brought** it **off**.
He **brought** the deal **off** in a
spectacular way.

bring up (1. separable):
mention (as a topic of
discussion).

We planned to discuss overtime
pay in the meeting. Why didn't
someone **bring** that topic **up**?

bring up (2.
separable) : raise;
rear.

Her grandparents **brought** her **up**."
