

## phrasal verbs with **come**

### **come across**

(inseparable): find  
(unexpectedly)

يصادف, يجد بالمصادفة

I've lost my extra car keys. If you **come across** them while you are cleaning the room, please put them in a safe place."

### **come down with** \_\_\_\_\_

(inseparable): become ill  
with –

يصاب (بمرض)

George won't be at the office today. He **came down with** the flu over the weekend.

**come to** (1.  
inseparable): total

يبلغ

Your charges **come to** \$124.38. Will you pay by check, in cash, or with a credit card?

**come to** (2. no object):  
regain consciousness

يسترد وعيه, يفيق من اغماء

When I told Gina that she'd won a million dollars, she fainted. When she **came to**, I told her it was a joke and she almost hit me!
