Future time words



Here are some examples of time words we use when we are talking about the future:

- *tomorrow*
*I'm leaving for France **tomorrow**.*
- *next week*
*I'll see you at the meeting **next week**.*
- *soon*
*Goodbye! I'll see you **soon**.*
- *later, after*
*I'll phone you **later**. (no object)*
I'll phone you after the film. (object)
- *in a moment, etc.*
*I'll be back **in a moment**.*
*I'll see you **in two weeks**.*
- *at (+ the time)*
*I'll be back **at 6.00**.*
