Negatives

I don't like ice-cream.

She doesn't eat chocolate.

I do not walk.

He does not walk.

We do not walk.

I don't walk.

He doesn't walk.

We don't walk.

You do not walk.

She does not walk.

They do not walk.

You don't walk.

She doesn't walk.

They don't walk.

It does not walk.

It doesn't walk.

Examples

I don't drink coffee.

They don't speak Italian.

Tom doesn't play tennis.

We don't live in France.

Questions

Do you walk to school or do you take the bus?

I usually walk.

Do I walk?

Does he walk?

Do we walk?

Do you walk?

Does she walk?

Do they walk?

Does it walk?

Examples

Do you like ice-cream?

Do they speak Italian?

Does Ana play basketball?

Do you live in Australia?

Does Harry often arrive late?

Do you usually get up at 7.30?

Careful!

I walk, you walk, we walk BUT he walks he walks, it walks

He walks.

Does he walk?

I don't walk.

BUT He doesn't walk. She doesn't walk.
