Are there many seats?

In informal statements, we use ***lots of***

There is lots of time.

There are lots of seats.

In formal statements, we use ***many***.

Many people believe in ghosts.

Mr Harrison visited Argentina many years ago.

How much...? uncountables

How much homework have you got?

Lots!

How much time have we got?

We've got fifteen

How much milk do you want?

minutes. Not much.

How many...? countables

How many pages do you have to read?

Ten.

How many brothers and sisters have you got?

Two brothers.

How many people are there here?

A hundred.

How many players are there?

Not very many.
